## *Neritina auriculata* Lamarck, 1816



- 
- Shell: Light brown, no pattern, often extended at the sides to form “wings.” Columellar area deep, cream-gray. Aperture cream.
- Operculum: Cream with gray radical lines and red outer horn border.
- Habitat: River and stream mouths, often in brackish water.
