



BOT 601 Foundations in Current Botany Policy

Approved by the Department of Botany 05 November 2013

All graduate students in the Department of Botany (MS Plan A, MS Plan B and PhD) are required to take BOT 601, a two-credit course that covers the breadth of botanical research topics represented in the Department. The course will be coordinated and led by a Department of Botany faculty member and will be offered in the fall semesters. Students are expected to take this course in their first year of the graduate program.
